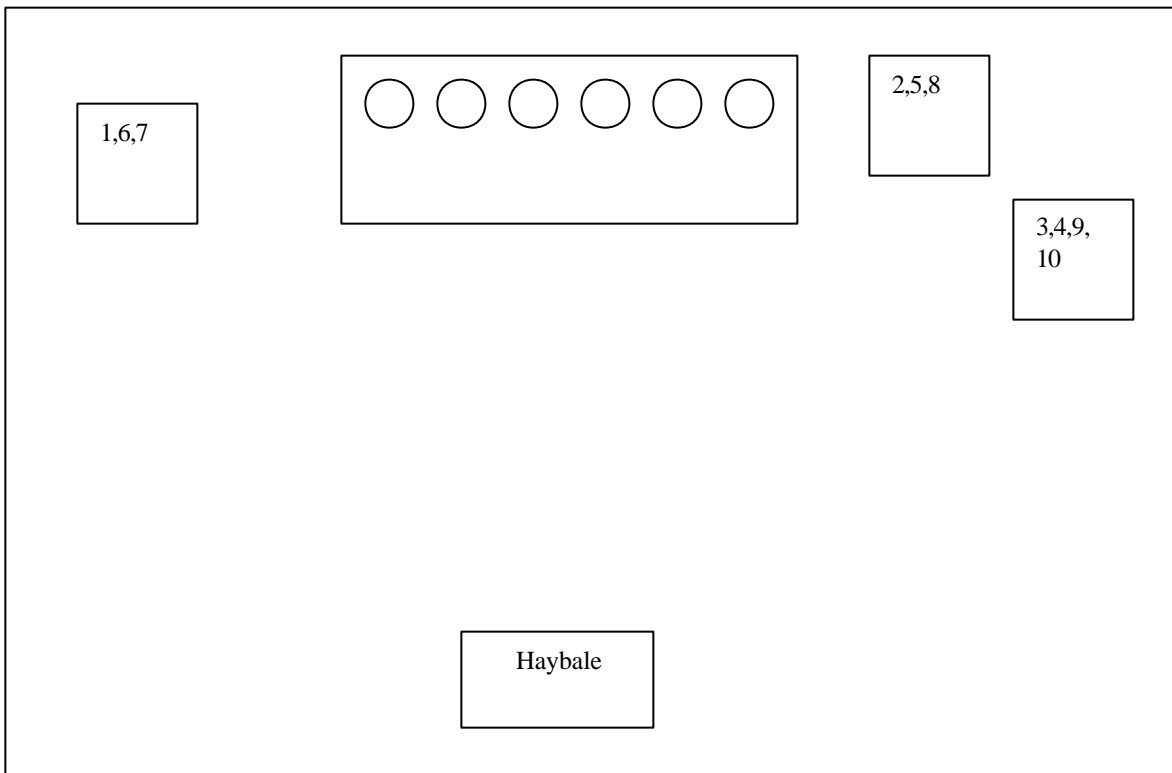


Attempted KC Train Robbery



You are on the outbound train leaving Kansas City for the gold fields of the west. A couple of miles outside of town, you hear a bunch 'o yellin and shootin'. Then the train suddenly stops. Knowing that this is a robbery, you ready yer shotgun and make sure yer pistols are loaded. When the robbers get to yer car, you shout to the person standing next you "I can take 'em" and you proceed to lay the robbers out!

2 pistols loaded with 5 rounds each, hammer on an empty chamber, and holstered. Shotgun, staged empty and open on the haybale, at least 6 rounds to be loaded from your person.

Shooter starts next to the haybale with hands at the surrender position. When ready, shooter calls out "I can take 'em". Pick up the shotgun and shoot the 6 falling plates. Plates must fall to count as a hit, take as many shots as needed to knock down all the plates. Set the shotgun back on the haybale, action open and empty. Draw your pistol and shoot the three steel targets in a sweep from left to right, then right to left, then left to right, finishing with a double tap on the last target (see picture above for clarification).
