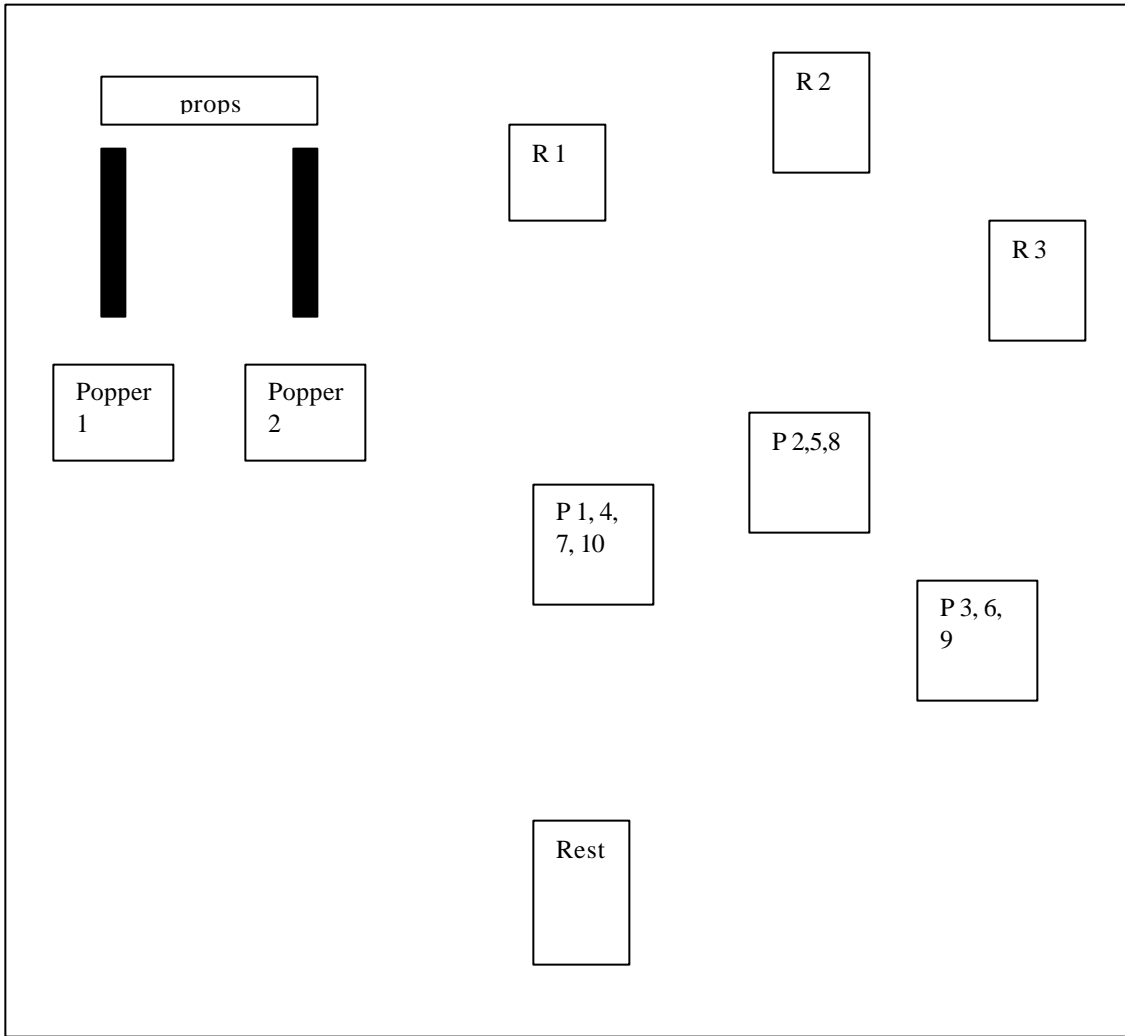


Birds for Dinner!



You are out hunting birds when you run across the men that burned out your last place. As soon as they recognize you, they come charging. As you shoot one with your shotgun, he flushes a bird as he falls. The second does that too. Not one to miss an opportunity, you shoot the birds for dinner. Then retrieve your rifle to take out a few more and then finish them off with your pistol.

2 pistols loaded with 5 rounds each, holstered, hammer on an empty chamber.

Rifle loaded with 10 rounds, hammer on the empty chamber, and staged on the rest (or haybale)

Shotgun at port arms with 4 rounds to be loaded from your person.

Shooter starts with shotgun at port arms, and says “gonna get me some birds for dinner”, then the timer starts. Shooter shoots the left popper and then the “bird” (charcoal briquette), then the right popper and the “bird”. 5 second bonus for each bird. Place the shotgun on the rest, action open and empty. The three rifle targets can be shot in any order, no double or triple taps, each must be shot 3 times, and the 10th shot must be on the center target. Place your rifle back on the rest, action open and empty. Shoot the 3 pistol targets sweeping left to right, 3 times, with your last shot on the left target (just like starting a 4th sweep).
