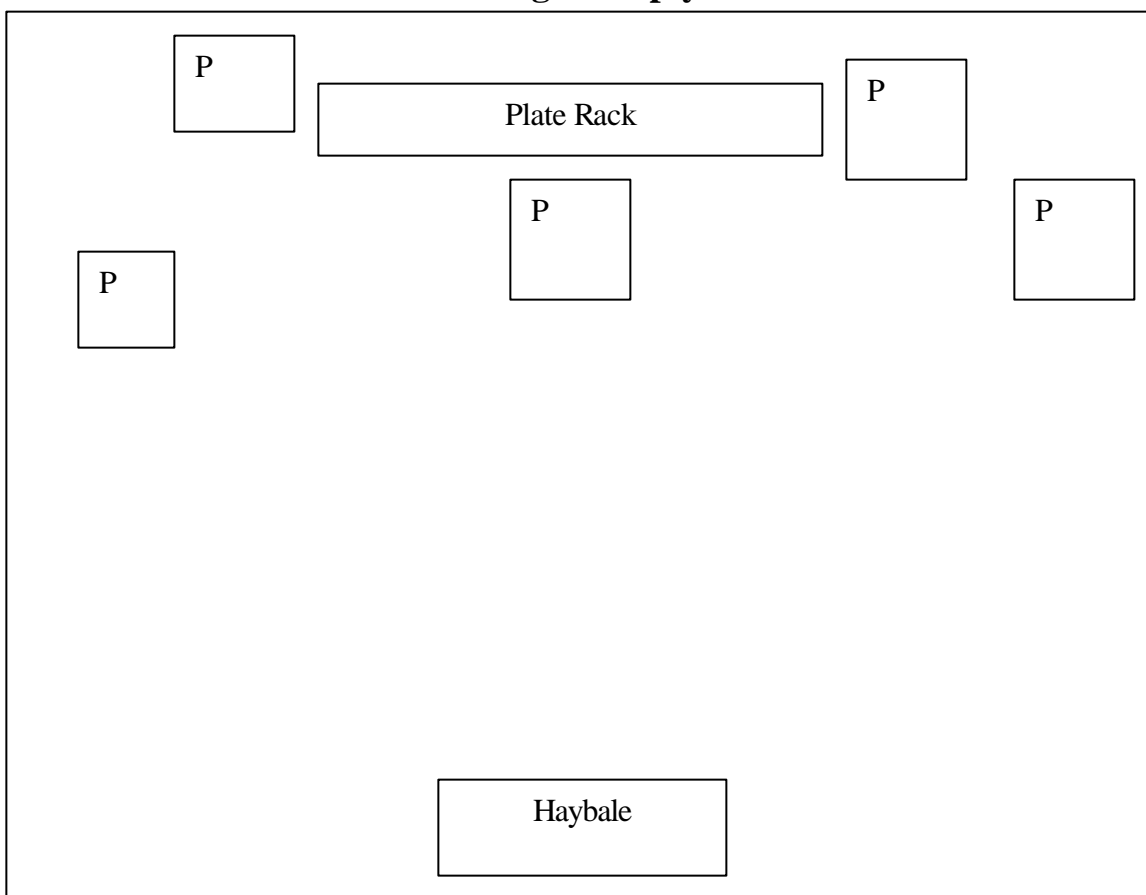


Caught Empty



It's early in the morning and you've just gotten up. As usual, you empty the cartridges out of one revolver to clean it. Just as you drop the last cartridge, you are set upon by Apache. You empty the full revolver, and knock 6 braves off their horses with the shotgun. You just have time to load the 2nd revolver before you are set upon again.

1 pistol loaded with 5 rounds, holstered, hammer resting on the empty chamber.
Shotgun staged on the haybale, action open and empty, at least 6 shells to be loaded from your person.
Other pistol holstered empty

Shooter starts with both hands holding 5 rounds of ammo. When ready, call out **"Caught Empty!"** At the buzzer, dump the 5 rounds into the metal box and then draw the loaded revolver and shoot the 5 pistol targets in any order, each target must be hit once. Holster. Pick up the shotgun and loading from your person, knock down the falling plates.
NOTE: '97 and '87 shooters may stoke up their shotguns on the clock. All plates must fall to count. Shooter may make up any missed shots. Place the open and empty shotgun back on the haybale. Load the empty revolver with the 5 rounds dumped into the tin and shoot the 5 pistol targets one time each in any order.
